



Activity

For 3-5s – Print page 26 onto paper for each child.

Before the lesson cut the page in half along the line. Cut the circle out and cut the hatched areas of the foot and the heart out.

The children colour the cross and colour the splatter mark to look dirty and messy (they will need to stay within the lines).

Help them to attach the circle behind the foot and heart with a paper fastener. They dial the circle to see how foot washing is a picture of the way the cross cleans our hearts.

For 5-7s – Print page 27 onto paper for each child. Use the page to discuss different practical ways in which the children can serve others.

Help the children to see that sometimes even things that are good to do don't mean that we are serving others.

Help them to also think through the motivation for serving others.

The children circle and colour only the serving pictures.

7-9s - Print page 28 onto paper for each child. Use the activity sheet to reinforce the lesson.

9-11s - Print page 29 onto paper for each child. Use the activity sheet to reinforce the lesson.



Extra Extra


Divide the children into groups of two or three. Get them to act out a scenario where the characters illustrate the principle of serving one another. These need to be realistic scenarios from their everyday experience.



Memory Verse


3-7's Proverbs 3:5a - *"Trust in the LORD with all your heart". [NIV]*

Jesus washed Peter's feet to show how Peter's heart would become clean when Jesus died. John 13:8


